Sewer Collection and Wastewater Treatment Improvements

KW Drilling (subcontractor to KPH) is planning to start installing the new sanitary force main pipe along the west boulevard of 3rd Avenue (Maple St–Elm St) and the north boulevard of Linden Street (3rd Ave–Hwy 15) in the coming weeks.

The force main will be installed by directional drilling (trenchless) method beneath each house's driveway. There will be trenches/pits in the boulevard in the locations shown on the exhibit. Roads will be open along 3rd Avenue and Linden Street with access to your driveways, with the exception of the intersection of 4th Avenue and Maple Street being closed as shown. Please be careful as you drive through this area, as equipment and workers will be on both sides of the street and in the boulevards.

What to Expect?

- Expect some dust, noise and minor inconveniences associated with construction.
- Regular working hours will generally be approximately 7 a.m. to 7 p.m, Monday–Friday.
- Traffic control barricades will be placed to protect both travelers and workers.
