Sewer Collection and Wastewater Treatment Improvements

KPH is planning to install the 14-inch new sanitary force main pipe across the intersection of Maple Street and Fourth Avenue this week, which will require a road closure.

There will be trenches/pits in the street & blvd in the locations shown on the exhibit. Maple Street will be open between Fourth Avenue and Third Avenue, with the exception of the intersection of Fourth Avenue and Maple Street being closed as shown. Please be careful as you drive through this area, as equipment and workers will be on both sides of the street and in the boulevards.

SAFETY IS EVERYONE'S PRIORITY. PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY!

What to Expect?

- Expect some dust, noise and minor inconveniences associated with construction.
- Regular working hours will generally be approximately 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday–Friday.
- Traffic control barricades will be placed to protect both travelers and workers.
