

### Pollinator Party Planned for April 27

SAVE THE DATE! Kindred Master Gardeners are hosting a "Pollinator Education Party" on Saturday, April 27, 2024 from 9-11 am at the Memorial Building. The event will feature guest speaker April Johnson, NDSU Extension Pollinator Technician, with the presentation titled "Designing а Pollinator Garden". There will also be a variety of tables related to pollinator resources, best pollinator plants and trees, and other related topics. This allages event is FREE and open to the public.

The "Pollinator Education Party" will also provide educational materials about the various pollinators in our region, the importance of pollinators, and what homeowners can do to plan the most ideal habitats for a variety of pollinators, including bees, birds, butterflies, and bats! Residents can have a major impact by providing suitable habitats and nutrition for all pollinators. By planting a pollinator garden or providing suitable habitats, you can turn your yard into an oasis for pollinators.

The Kindred Master Gardeners and other experts will be available to answer your green-thumb questions!





## Pollinator Garden Summary

- Choose two or more perennial species from each seasonal flowering category (spring, June, summer and fall) for a minimum of eight plant species in the pollinator garden. Plant multiples of each species. Select predominantly native species for your pollinator garden. Avoid planting cultivars with extra petals (double-flowered). Create a water source. Provide habitat for groundnesting and cavity-nesting bees. Be wise in your use of pesticides and avoid spraving blooming plants.



## MDU Natural Gas Kindred

The March 31 deadline for residents and businesses to submit their applications and deposit to secure a natural gas connection to their property is soon approaching. MDU needs at least 40% of homes and businesses to determine the projects viability in Kindred.

There are several options to complete an application: 1) complete or pick up an application at Kindred City Hall and return with the appropriate deposit in the postage paid envelope; 2) download an application from the Montana-Dakota website: www.montanadakota.com > "What's New" tab > Special Projects > Kindred, click on "Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. - Application for Service Form".

A determination will be made mid-April, and if the project reaches the 40% commitment, construction could begin late summer/fall of 2024 with customer conversions starting in November of 2024.

## Spring Clean Up

### CURBSIDE CLEAN UP - SATURDAY, APRIL 27, 2024

Curbside clean up services are provided by Waste Management and are available for single-family homes and mobile home locations who pay a monthly city garbage fee. This service is not available for commercial or multi-family properties. Residents will be allowed to leave acceptable bulky garbage on their street, avenue, or boulevard - items WILL NOT be picked up in the alley.

The allowable quantity per residence is approximately two yards of material. Sanitation workers will begin early Saturday morning. Please be attentive of the weather/wind when planning to put out discarded items to help alleviate any possible debris being blown into neighbors' yards or city streets.

Please note that any items deemed unacceptable or to be a hazard to the driver or collection vehicle will need to be removed from the boulevard by Wednesday, May 1, 2024.

### **ACCEPTABLE ITEMS**

- Paint cans (lids off & dried)
- Bulky household items including chairs, sofas, mattresses, furniture, toilets, etc.
- Large items that will not fit in your weekly garbage service tote

### X UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Appliances, electronics
- Household hazardous waste
- Items containing freon
- Lawn mowers/small engines containing fuel or liquids
- Liquids of any type
- Propane tanks, gas cans
- Tires, batteries, metals
- Cement blocks, masonry bricks, or other types of landscape support
- Construction/demolition materials



### METAL & APPLIANCE PICK UP - MONDAY, APRIL 29

Kindred Public Works will be picking up METAL APPLIANCES and FREON-CONTAINING items on Monday, April 29, 2024. Please have your appliance(s) curbside by 7:00 a.m.

<u>A fee of \$50.00 per appliance</u> will be billed to the resident's monthly City of Kindred utility bill.

# Lead Free ND

As part of a nationwide initiative related to the **Lead and Copper Rule**, North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality, is requesting residents and property owners submit information on their water service pipe material to comply with EPA Regulations. This initiative will allow water providers to document the presence of lead service pipes in their systems. **This survey must be done by April 1st.** 



The following survey should take approximately **5 minutes** and walk you through how to find your property's water service pipe. To complete the survey, you'll also need a coin, magnet, and smartphone. Please follow the directions in the survey for specifics.
