What This Means for Kindred Residents

Under the newly adopted policy, Kindred residents may now offer comments during council meetings—but within clearly defined parameters:

- Time Limits: The council may set limits on the total duration of the public comment period and/or the time allotted per speaker.
- **Topic Restrictions:** Comments must pertain to items listed on the current meeting's agenda or those discussed in the preceding meeting.
- Conduct Guidelines: Remarks must remain respectful and constructive. Defamatory, abusive, or disruptive comments will not be permitted.

The policy balances the spirit of open dialogue with the need to maintain orderly and efficient meetings. Council welcomes public input and want to ensure it's both meaningful and manageable.

Residents wishing to speak during the public comment period are concise remarks relevant to listed agenda topics. At the regular Effective August 1, 2025, Senate Bill 2180 requires all city councils meeting, speaker cards will be available to fill out asking for your minutes.

> As the city adopts this new requirement, residents are invited to engage respectfully and constructively—helping shape the future of Kindred, one voice at a time.

How to Request to be on the Agenda




