

## Community of Care Adds Part-time Faith Community Nurse to Kindred Area

Community of Care has offices in Arthur, Casselton, and as of March, Kindred is added to that list. The Kindred office is located in the Alsager Meats building. Charley Rose has been hired as the part-time Faith Community Nurse working Mondays and Thursdays. Charley is a licensed RN and has worked in a variety of nursing settings. As a Faith Community Nurse, he provides individual visits with clients to help them understand their medical conditions, physician's orders, and medications. Charley can also assist clients to arrange for in-home services or equipment. Faith Community Nurses cannot provide hands-on care due to their scope of practice, but rather they focus on preventative care and education.

Community of Care serves older adults throughout the 1,700 square mile area of rural Cass County, with the goal of assisting

older adults to remain in their homes as long as safely possible. The primary demographic is individuals age 65+. Throughout their 20-year history, all programs and services have been provided Free-Of-Charge, thanks to grantors and generous local donors.



Community of Care provides Care Coordination, Medicare Part D Drug Plan enrollment, assistance with paperwork (food/fuel/prescription assistance forms and Advance Care Plans), referrals, information, facilitation of transportation to medical appointments, Bone Builder exercise classes in 7 communities (including Kindred and Davenport), Faith Community Nurse services, and assistance for adult children of aging parents.

### DO NOT DUMP MATERIALS ON GROUND!

Whether the containers are full or not, do NOT leave yard waste on the ground. This is considered illegal dumping - users could be cited with fines up to \$200.00. This area is monitored; empty containers will be requested as needed.

### GRASS/LEAVES/BRANCHES ONLY!

The compost container site is NOT a collection site for appliances, dressers, shoes, rocks, lumber, or junk of any kind - inside or outside the containers. This is considered illegal dumping punishable by fines up to \$200.00 (City Ordinance Ch 15-0311).

### DO NOT OVERLOAD CONTAINERS!

If the containers are full, do NOT continue to pile branches on top of the containers. This creates difficulties and hazards for the truck driver and others on the road. Please check back the following day, as we monitor this daily and request empty containers as needed. Empty containers usually arrive within a day, depending on availability of drivers and containers.

### NO PLASTIC BAGS!

Do not place plastic bags into the compost containers. If you use a bag to haul your grass/leaves, please use the garbage tote provided to dispose of your bags. If there are items in the grass/leaves container other than grass/leaves, it cannot be disposed of properly and must be hauled to the landfill instead, incurring additional charges. Residents will incur these additional charges that may be up to \$200.00.

### RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY!

Compost containers are available for City of Kindred residents. Use of the containers is prohibited to commercial lawn care businesses. The compost containers are under 24-hour video surveillance. Non compliance of the rules may result in a fine.

## PLEASE USE THE CORRECT CONTAINER!

ONLY LEAVES & GRASS in the leaves & grass container! ONLY BRANCHES in the branches container!

NO DUMPING ON THE GROUND! PUT MATERIALS **INSIDE** THE CONTAINERS!

### UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Tree stumps, Dirt  
Plastic Bags, Garbage  
Railroad Ties  
Commercial Lawn/Yard Waste  
Bricks/Stones  
Dog & Pet Waste/Cat Litter  
Shoes, Glass, TVs  
(Basically, if it isn't listed on the "Acceptable Items" list, it isn't allowed. Question about an item? Please call City Hall first before dumping your item in the compost containers.)



### Acceptable Items

Small Tree Branches  
(> 6" diameter)  
Brush  
Small Limbs  
Sticks

The compost containers are  
under video  
**24-hour surveillance.**  
Noncompliance of the rules  
may result in a fine.

According to Kindred City Ordinance Chapter 15-0311, noncompliance of the above rules is considered illegal dumping and Cass County Sheriff Department can issue a citation with fines up to \$200.00.
